


KS1 and KS2 have been really enjoying their computing learning, especially in the last few weeks now that they have been able to use their new Chromebooks.




KS1 children have been making their own pop-up Mosques this week, sharing what they know about places of Worship and what they are made up of.

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
World Book Day - Tuesday 5th March


The children will also team up with the digital ambassadors at Le Cateau when we visit for Forest Schools.
