
Thank you to all those who have booked their slots already. If you need any assistance booking in, please speak with Miss Jenkins or Miss Rush.

Class 2 have been busy in in History this week researching their favourite part of Mayan Civilisation. Some of which included: war; food; hot chocolate and fashion.


News


Deadlines and Reminders

- A reminder for anyone on the residential to London to please ensure payments are up to date.








World Book Day - Tuesday 5th March
