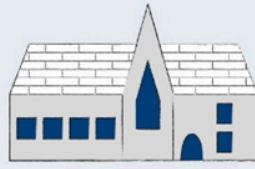
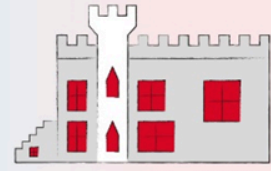

How pupils understand Religious Beliefs across the Federation...

In R.E, we follow the North Yorkshire Agreed Syllabus. Throughout this, pupils learn about and from religious and non-religious worldviews in local, national and global contexts, to discover, explore and consider different answers to thought provoking and challenging questions .Pupils learn to weigh up the value of wisdom from different sources, to develop and express their insights in response, and to agree or disagree respectfully.

Pupils will be equipped with systematic knowledge and understanding of a range of religious and non-religious worldviews, enabling them to develop their ideas, values and identities. They will develop an aptitude for dialogue so that they can participate positively in our society, with its diverse religious and non-religious worldviews.
